**SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES**  
**for attending the**  
**DIPLOMA & MASTER IN ADVANCED EUROPEAN STUDIES 2023/2024**

The European College of Parma Foundation is offering a few **partial scholarships for participating in the Diploma and Master in Advanced European Studies (DAES) 2023/2024**. Relevant eligibility criteria and requirements are specified below.

The offer includes the following **Partial Scholarships**, as detailed below:

- A) 5 Partial Scholarships, merit&income-based, addressed to candidates that are either Italian citizens or foreigners residing in Italy, whose ISEE income is lower than € 27000 and whose Graduation mark is at least 104/110 or higher.**

This scholarship leads to a **special 50%** reduction of the regular enrolment fee. For this reason, the exceptional enrolment fee that will derive from that will amount to **Euro 2500** (including VAT) instead of Euro 5000 (including VAT).

***Requirements for applying***

This type of partial scholarship is addressed to Italian candidates and to candidates of any nationality who reside in Italy, **whose ISEE income is lower than Euro 27000**. Candidates shall submit the document named "ISEE Università" that has current validity on the date of submission of the application for the partial scholarship. In case of equal evaluations, priority will be given to candidates having completed their Second Cycle University degrees (i.e. with 5 years of university studies) and B2 (or higher) English skills.

- B) 5 Partial Scholarships, addressed to Italian citizens and foreigners residing in Italy, whose ISEE income is lower than € 35000.**

This scholarship leads to a 40% reduction of the regular enrolment fee. The exceptional enrolment fee that will derive from this scholarship will therefore amount to **Euro 3000** (including VAT) instead of Euro 5000 (including VAT).

***Requirements for applying***

This type of partial scholarship is addressed to Italian candidates and to candidates of any nationality who reside in Italy, **whose ISEE income is lower than Euro 27000**. Candidates shall submit the document named "ISEE Università" that has current validity on the date of submission of the application for the partial scholarship. In case of equal evaluations, priority will be given to candidates having completed their Second Cycle University degrees (i.e. with 5 years of university studies) and B2 (or higher) English skills.

- C) 5 Partial Scholarships for EU citizens and third-country nationals that are currently residing within the EU, whose family income is lower than € 35000.**

This scholarship involves a 40% reduction of the regular enrolment fee. The exceptional enrolment fee that will derive from this scholarship will thus amount to **Euro 3000** (including VAT) instead of Euro 5000 (including VAT).

***Requirements for applying***

This type of partial scholarship is addressed to **candidates who are either nationals of a EU Member State or who are of any nationality but residing within in one of the EU Member States, with family income that is**

**lower than Euro 35000** (or equivalent amounts in the relevant currency). Family income data shall be certified through official documents, issued by competent authorities.

Subject of the analysis will be the income of the candidate's family of origin, unless all the following criteria are jointly met by a candidate living outside of the family of origin: the candidate has been living outside of the original household for at least 2 years on the date of submission of the application; the place the candidate is living at is not owned by any of his/her family member; the candidate has been earning an income of his/her own amounting to at least Euro 7000 per year for at least 2 years. Candidates who live outside of the original household but do not meet all of the above-listed requirements must submit documents pertaining to income of both the family of origin and the current household.

### FURTHER REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLYING

The General Requirements specified below are applicable for all potential candidates who wish to apply within the framework of this partial scholarship offer (regardless of the category – A, B or C – they are applying under).

#### *General Requirements:*

The offer is addressed to **candidates who hold at least a 3-year Bachelor's Degree in law, economics, political science, social science, language studies, humanities**. The Foundation may analyse profiles of candidates holding University Degrees in other disciplines if relating to subjects dealt with within the DAES study programme.

The University degree shall have been fully achieved by the day of submission of the application, or it shall be necessarily fully achieved no later than 31<sup>st</sup> October 2023 (if the university degree is not achieved by that date, the scholarship will be declared null and will be revoked). Holding a University Degree by the deadline of this Offer (9 September 2023) will be a preferential feature.

### HOW TO APPLY

Applications for the above-described partial scholarships shall be submitted by e-mail to the European College of Parma Foundation (email address: [apply@collegioeuropeo.it](mailto:apply@collegioeuropeo.it)) no later than **9 September 2023**.

Prospective applicants must submit the following documents:

- 1) **Application dossier** (consisting in the applicable DAES 2023/2024 Application Form and relevant annexes);
- 2) **Motivation letter**, specifically written (separate from the Application Form) with regard to the scholarship application; candidates shall also specify, within this Motivation Letter, for which of the three scholarship categories they are applying (A, B or C).
- 3) **Official documents attesting family incomes** during year 2022. In the case of candidates residing in Italy, such official documents consist in "ISEE Università" that has current validity on the date of submission of the application for the partial scholarship.

In the case of applicants residing outside of Italy, candidates are required to submit, besides official certification of household composition, adequate official statements (if applicable, translated into Italian, English or French) relating to financial and property situation of their households during the financial year 2022, issued by the competent authority of the country where income is received and property is possessed. Scholarship grantees may subsequently be required to submit certified translations of the above documents and/or official verifications thereof by the relevant Italian diplomatic representations. The requested documentation may be replaced by a certificate issued in Italian language by the Embassy / Consulate of the relevant country in Italy.

**SELECTION AND AWARDING CRITERIA**

Candidates meeting the above-specified requirements – based on the analysis of their respective application dossiers and above-listed annexes – will be contacted to make individual appointments for online interviews with representatives of the Foundation. The interview will be focussing mainly on the analysis of the candidate's motivation and on verification of actual language skills.

Successful candidates will be notified as soon as possible.

The Foundation reserves the right not to grant the above partial scholarships, should the applications received within the framework of this offer not qualify for the applicable requirements.
