

CESARE AZZALI

Born in Parma on 13 February 1954

After finishing classical studies at "Giandomenico Romagnosi" High-School, Parma, he enrolled at the Law Faculty where he graduated (mark: cum laude) writing a final dissertation on: Conferment Conflicts among State Powers.

After graduating he immediately started collaboration with the constitutional law department of the University of Parma.

In 1981, he was employed as officer of the Parma Entrepreneurs' Association (UPI) where, in 1984, he became Head of Economic Services.

Since 1990, he has been a researcher of Constitutional Law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Parma.

From 1994 to 1998 he was professor of Institutions of *Public Law*, and in 1988/99 of *Public Law of Economics* at the Faculty of Economics.

From 1995 to 1999 he was professor of *Environmental Law and Legislation* at the Faculty of Science.

He has collaborated with the National School for Public Administration (Scuola Superiore della Pubblica Amministrazione - SSPA) of the Presidency of Council of Ministers, where he held lectures and seminars on environmental law.

He is currently professor at the European College of Parma.

Cesare Azzali has developed an intense research activity in various sectors of public law and he is also the author of many monographic books and law-related articles.

In addition to university activities, from 1990 he has continued to work in the Parma Entrepreneurs' Association where he has coordinated the associations' economic services.

From 1 September 2000, he is director of the Parma Entrepreneurs' Association.

Cesare Azzali is member of several board of associations.

From July 2002, he is President of the European College of Parma Foundation.
